

KBFX/Hometown Sports Game Saving Play Of The Week Contest Rules

Who Is Eligible

1. To be eligible to be nominated in this contest, nominees must be California residents who are 15 years of age or older and play football at one of the participating high schools defined below. Nominations are not open to the public.

Participating High Schools: Mira Monte, Ridgeview, South, Golden Valley, West, Liberty, Centennial, Frontier, Bakersfield, East, Garces, Independence, Tehachapi, Foothill, North, Highland, Bakersfield Christian, Wasco, Shafter, Taft, Arvin, Chavez, Kennedy, Delano, McFarland, Stockdale, Kern Valley, Frazier Mountain, Maricopa, NW Christian, Porterville, Monache, and Boron.

2. Employees of Sinclair Broadcast Group, Inc., Sinclair Television Group, Inc., Sinclair Television Media, Inc., and any other company which owns, programs or provides other services to television broadcast station KBAK/KBFX (collectively, the "Station") Trinity Safety Company, their affiliated companies, advertising and promotion agencies, any and all local television broadcast and cable stations, local radio and other media companies, and the immediate family members of each are ineligible. The term "immediate family" includes spouses, grandparents, parents, siblings, children and grandchildren.

How Weekly Winners Are Selected

- a) No purchase is necessary to be entered.
- b) The contest starts on August 29, 2014, and ends on November 30, 2014 (the "Contest Period"). Each week during the Contest Period, the Station's Sport Anchors Greg Kerr and Jon Tritsch will review game plays from the Participating High Schools that made the difference between victory and defeat. The plays will be judged and scored based on the following criteria: 70% Execution of the Play, 15% Quality of the Opponent, and 15% Game Situation at the Time of Play.
- c) Each Sunday during the Contest Period, the one (1) game play with the highest score based on the criteria set forth above will be declared the "Game Saving Play of the Week", for a total of fourteen (14) Game Saving Plays of the Week. In the event of a tie, one (1) winning game play will be selected by random drawing from among the tied plays. The player(s) that executed the Game Saving Play of the Week will be recognized as the winner(s).
- d) At the end of the season, the one (1) Game Saving Play of the Week with the highest score based on the criteria set forth above will be declared the "Game Saving Play of the Season." The decisions of the judges shall be final with regard to all matters in this contest.
- e) Each Sunday during the Contest Period, the Game Saving Play of the Week will be announced during the Hometown Sports program at 5:00 p.m. PT on KBFX-CD Channel 58. The Game Saving Play of the Season will be announced on the Hometown Sports finale program on a date yet to be determined. Players may be invited to attend the Hometown Sports finale program.

The Prize(s)

1. Each player(s) that executed the Game Saving Play of the Week will receive one (1) Hometown Sports/Trinity Safety Company Hard Hat valued at \$25. The player(s) who made the Game Saving Play of the Season will receive a plaque valued at \$150. One (1) Game Saving Play of the Season player will receive a \$1,000 scholarship. In the event more than one player made the Game Saving Play of the Season, a panel of three (3) judges comprised of Station personnel will review the Game Saving Play of the Season and determine one (1) player who was most integral to the success of the play and overall result of the game. The one (1) player will receive the \$1,000 scholarship. The Scholarship must be used during the first year after high school graduation at an institution of higher learning, and is subject to the terms and conditions of the provider.
2. Each player will be notified through his/her school football coach or an official from the school. Before claiming prizes, each player must provide his/her correct name, address and telephone number to Station within three (3) days of notification. Each player must sign and return a release and affidavit of eligibility, which must be received within five (5) days of notification, at the time each player claims his/her prize in person at the Station. If a player is a minor, then the player's parent or guardian must sign a release and affidavit of eligibility before the player receives his or her prize. Each player must show picture identification to claim prizes. Station reserves the right to examine additional identification and may choose to accept or deny awarding the prize based on the identification presented.
3. If a player does not respond to the notification within three (3) days, or does not timely sign and return the release and affidavit of eligibility, then the prize will be forfeited, an alternate player will not be selected, and the prize will remain the property of the Station.
4. There will be no substitutions or cash alternatives for any prize except at the sole discretion of Station. The Station has the right to substitute a prize of similar value. No transfer or assignment of prizes is allowed.
5. Each winner is responsible for paying all local, county, state and federal taxes on prizes based on the estimated retail value of the prizes as set forth in these rules. Each winner must complete and sign a Form W-9.
